

Good Afternoon Jamie,

In September, Thornapple Township Emergency Services was approached and asked to provide a cost for TTES to cover the SE corner of Irving Township. This section is identified as section 270 at Barry County Central Dispatch. Thornapple Township has compiled all of the expenses such as wages, insurance, fuel, maintenance medical supplies, etc. to reach a reasonable number.

Irving has contracted fire protection with TTES for over 20 years, covering roughly the western 1/3 of Irving Township, including the community of Irving. The ambulance has tagged along with this area and has also been covering the northern portion of Irving Township, including the Village of Freeport. The ambulance has been a "no charge" for this area. In the future, we should look at a committee from both township boards to review the needs and come to a number that will work best for both parties.

We have determined the Ambulance coverage for this portion of Irving would be a charge of \$4500.00. This would likely need to be reviewed every year or two to keep up with the ever rising expenses.

If this proposal is excepted, we believe that the contract should have a clause to allow either party to escape the contract with a ___days' notice due to extenuating circumstances (such as dissatisfaction, unforeseen issues, etc.)
